TRAVEL INFORMATION

From Bologna Airport to Bologna city centre

The shuttle Aerobus takes you from Bologna Airport to "Bologna Centrale" train station (<u>https://aerobus.bo.it/en</u>). It runs every 11 minutes and takes 20 minutes to reach the train station.

A single journey costs 6 EUR and tickets can be bought at the airport, or on the bus, or online beforehand on the above-mentioned website.

Taxi is another option, costing around 20 EUR.

From the train station you can walk to the heart of the city centre or take several bus lines departing just in front of the train station. For more information on bus routes please visit <u>https://www.tper.it/</u>or you can consult google maps.

The city centre can easily be reached on foot thanks to the famous arcades and also the meeting place is quite close to the centre.

MEALS

During the meeting, the University of Bologna will offer 2 basic coffee breaks, 1 finger lunch and 1 dinner. On the 1st day of activity, finger lunch will be served in the Sala De Aloisio in front of Sala Sfameni (meeting place). On the same day, partners are invited to a joint dinner at the Buca Manzoni Restaurant located in via Manzoni, n. 6G.

LEISURE TIME

On the 1st day, after the meeting, there will be a guided visit to the city centre to discover the main attractions of Bologna: Piazza Maggiore with the Basilica of San Petronio, Palazzo del Podestà, Palazzo Re Enzo and Palazzo D'Accursio, Piazza Nettuno with its famous fountain, Palazzo dell'Archiginnasio, home of the ancient university and the headquarters of the Medical Surgical Society, one of the oldest. The itinerary will continue through the streets of the Medieval Market, the heart of Bolognese gastronomy and will continue towards Piazza della Mercanzia with the homonymous Palace and the millennium-old Santo Stefano Church. The visit of the Two Towers, symbol of the city, will complete the discovery of the places of main interest.
